Vodafone – FITA Mobile Telephony Accessibility Initiative

Overview

The Mobile Accessibility Initiative is a joint effort between the Foundation Information technology Accessibility (FITA) and Vodafone Foundation Malta, to facilitate access to mobile and smart telephone functionality for visually impaired and/or deaf persons. The duration period is for two years starting from October 2012 and ending in October 2014.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must be at least 12 years old and hold a valid SID issued by KNPD.
- Only disabled persons with impairments which severely effect their hearing and/or vision are eligible.
- The application must properly completed and be sent to FITA. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- The grant amount per application will not exceed the sum of €300.00 (Three Hundred Euros).

Terms and Conditions

- Software installation of accessible technology must be done and verified by authorised FITA personnel.
- Relevant mobile phone devices must be bought directly from the Vodafone outlet.
- Any one applicant can benefit from this scheme only once.
- The applicant cannot dispose from products obtained under this scheme within two years from the date of issue, but must otherwise return them to FITA.
- Applicants under this initiative accept that the decision of FITA is final and binding in all respects.
- FITA reserves the right to make changes to these terms and the application process at any time without notice.
